SPACES

- Café on the Square continued to be a welcoming place for everyday connection, serving over 4,000 mugs of tea throughout 2025.
- Three local schools now partner with the Community Garden, using it as a resource for outdoor learning.
- The Methodist Church welcomed and hosted more than 25 community groups over the year.
